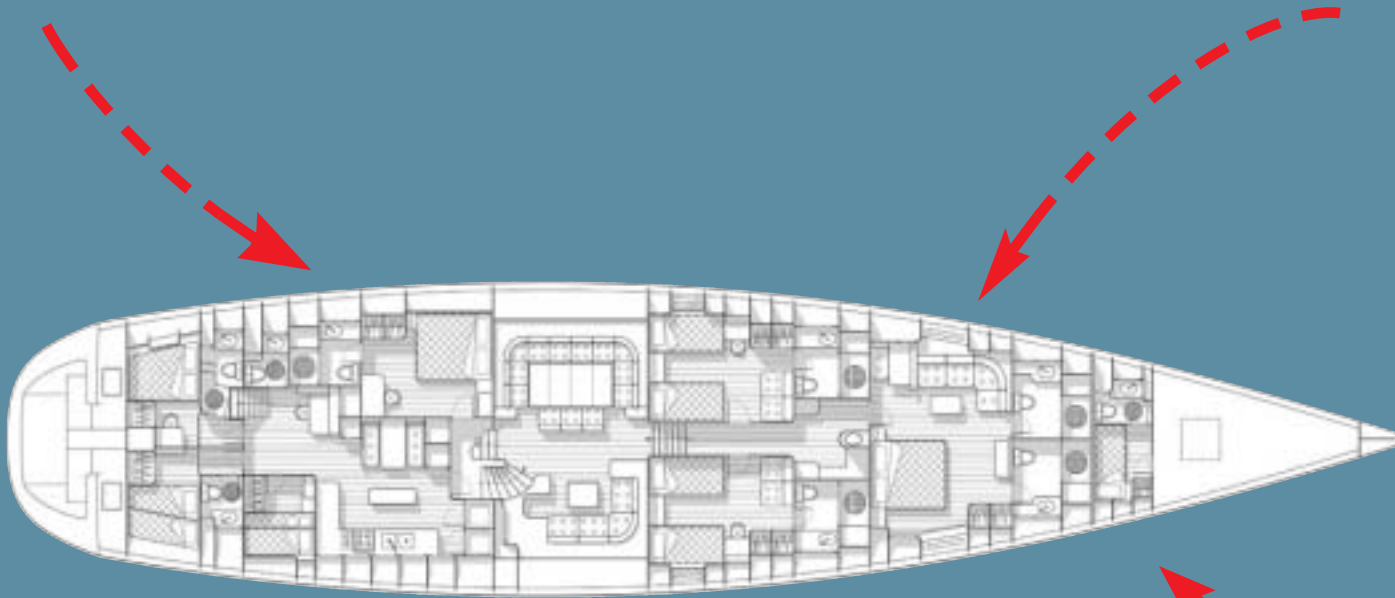
Trained by famous French chefs, the cook will brighten up the cruises by high quality and international meals. The open galley and spacious mess makes it a pleasant and practical area for the crew.

All guests cabin are equipped with LCD screens, video and music players.

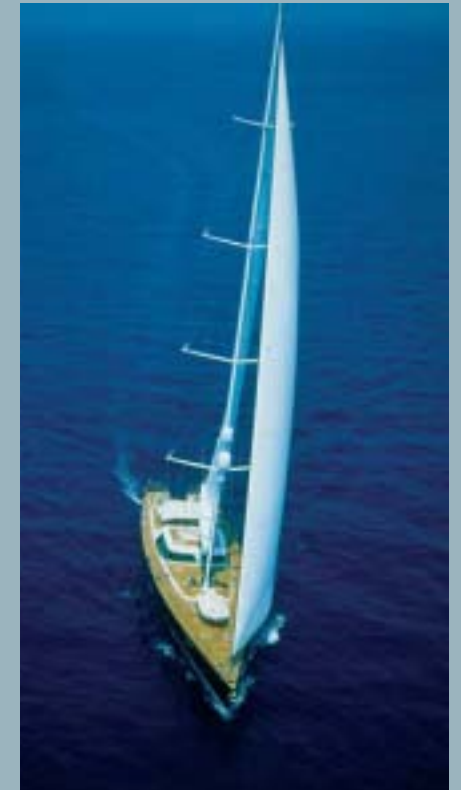
